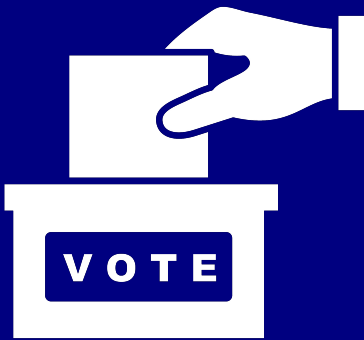


Voting Options

For those who are unhoused or without proof of residence

- Advance Polls take place on October 26-27, 2025
- Special Ballot Applications close Oct 31, 2025
- Polling Day takes place on November 3, 2025



HOW CAN I GET REGISTERED TO VOTE IF I'M UNHOUSED:



You can use an address where you regularly access services, meals, or are regularly staying.

This could be a shelter, a drop-in organization, a food bank, or a even community health centre that's near where you currently sleep and stay.

DO I NEED TO PROVIDE PROOF OF MY ADDRESS?



Yes.

Elections Yukon provides an attestation form that can used by a person who does not have proof of residence, called:

Attestation of Residence of a Service Provider
— Form 350 —

A signed confirmation letter may also be used to confirm your address, or for tenant electors who don't have documentation of their tenancy.

DO I NEED TO PROVIDE ID?



Yes.

The attestation provides proof of address, but you'll still need to provide something with your name on it to verify your identity as well.

There are many options to choose from!

Accepted Identification



- Bank statement
- Personal cheque
- Birth certificate
- Burning permit
- Camping permit
- Canadian Citizenship card
- Canadian Passport
- Certificate of Indian Status Card
- Credit card or debit card
- Employee identification card
- First Nation Citizenship card
- First Nation Government ID card
- General Identification Card
- Health services ID band (i.e., a patient wrist band)
- Income tax document
- Letter from Chief/Registrar of a First Nation Government
- Library card w/ name on it
- Marriage certificate
- Old Age Security card
- Prescription Medicine Container
- Possession and Acquisition (Firearms) license
- Social Insurance card
- 2025 Voter Information Card

There are more accepted forms of ID beyond this list, too.

HOW DOES VOUCHING WORK?



Vouching is only possible at the Ordinary Polls on Polling Day.

A registered elector can vouch for the identity and address of another who lives within the same electoral district, if that person is without proof of identification or residence.

The person vouching must:

- Believe that they know the Vouchee's identity.
- Believe that the Vouchee resides at the address they provided.
- Vouch for only one person.
