The Yukon Anti-Poverty Coalition works towards eliminating poverty in the Yukon through awareness, advocacy, community building, education and action. Our members partner with staff and other community members on issues involving income, food, shelter and access to services. Our main projects currently include: *Voices influencing Change*, *Whitehorse Connects*, *the Community Garden*, and programming for tenants who live at 60 Selkirk and Yukon Housing Seniors buildings. We actively advocate for systems that uphold basic human rights and recognize the importance of equity and inclusion.

Ways to be involved:

As a General member – receive regular newsletters, attend monthly meetings, contribute to the discussion, involve yourself in issues you are passionate about, volunteer to help organize and deliver projects, services or fundraising activities (around 2 hours a month or less depending on how often you attend our meetings or gatherings.)

As a Board member – respond to emails from staff, attend board meetings, opportunity to participate in projects and contribute to decision making (around 4-5 hours per month)

As an Executive board member (3 co-chairs, secretary, treasurer) – attend monthly co-chair meetings and monthly general meetings, contribute to decision making and projects, etc. (around 5 hours per month)

Membership is free! Just fill out the membership form.

You can choose to be a voting member or a non-voting member. Most decisions are made by consensus: votes are always taken at our Annual General Meeting to approve financial statements, Board appointments and other related issues as per our bylaws.

Voting members: Yukon residents or a Yukon registered non-profit organization. Board members must be voting members.

Non-voting members: individuals or not-profit organizations who do not want to vote OR general members who are non-Yukon residents, out-of-Territory organizations, corporations, government departments or agencies.
